Income is the money received by any member of the household before deductions as taxes and Social Security. It includes the following:

Salary or wages; earnings from self employment, including fishing & farming; welfare & unemployment; child support & alimony; strike benefits; Social Security, pensions, retirement & disability payments; & other cash income received or withdrawn from any source which would be available for payment of a child's meal. Each household member's PFD must be prorated as contributing to the total monthly household income. Food stamp benefits are NOT included.

HOUSEHOLD OR FAMILY: Is defined as followed:

A group of related or unrelated individuals who are living as one economic unit

WHAT IS TEFAP? United States Dept. of Agriculture (USDA) commodities distributed under The Emergency Food Assistance Program (**TEFAP**) solely for the benefit of household consumption to low income individuals and families. Foods may include canned fruits, vegetables and meats, dry goods such as milk, cereals, rice pasta and potatoes, nuts, and frozen meats depending on availability.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE? Households with an income which does not exceed 185% of the poverty level as established by the federal government. (See T.E.F.A.P. Income Guidelines on the back)

HOW DO I APPLY FOR TEFAP? The Kenai Peninsula Food Bank office has applications available.

HOW OFTEN CAN I RECEIVE TEFAP? TEFAP is available to each household once each calendar month. Recipients can register at only one TEFAP distribution center. Recipients can change TEFAP distribution center once per year. **WARNING:** Records are kept on a statewide basis. Duplication of services is prohibited and will result in denial of TEFAP commodities.

DOES TEFAP REPLACE OTHER FOOD ASSISTANCE? No. TEFAP is provided in addition to the direct service emergency food boxes available at the Kenai Peninsula Food Bank.

WHERE CAN I GET TEFAP? TEFAP is available at the Kenai Salvation Army and at the Kenai Peninsula Food Bank.
