Income is the money received by any member of the household before deductions such as taxes and Social Security. It includes the following:

Salary or wages; earnings from self employment, including fishing an farming; welfare and unemployment; child support & alimony; strike benefits; Social Security, pensions, retirement & disability payments; & other cash income received or withdrawn from any source which would be available for payment of a child's meal. Each household member's PFD must be prorated as contributing to the total monthly household income. Food stamp benefits are NOT included.

HOUSEHOLD OR FAMILY: Is defined as followed:

A group of related or unrelated individuals who are living as one economic unit.
